4-H DAY GUIDELINES

- Novelty** -----No size or age limit - 1 number, not to exceed 5 minutes
- Reading** -----Individual Activity - 1 number, not to exceed 5 minutes, script required
- Skit/One-Act Play** ----- Any size or any age - original script must be presented to the judge-1 number, not to exceed 10 minutes
- Dance Routines** ----- 1 or more, any age - 1 number, not to exceed 5 minutes
- Chorus** ----- 11 or more 4-Hers, any age - 2 numbers, **must be memorized****
- Vocal Ensemble** ----- 2 to 10 4-Hers, any age - 2 numbers **must be memorized****
- Instru Ensemble**----- 2 or more 4-Hers any age -2 numbers**
- Vocal Solo** -----Individual, 2 age groups -1 number **must be memorized****
- Instrumental Solo** ---- Individual - 2 age groups -1 number**
- Project Talks**----- Individual Jr. Only – Must be enrolled in project, 2-7 minutes, visuals optional
- Public Speaking** ----- Individual Sr. Only - 15 minutes maximum, visuals optional, provide outline, 1-2 note cards suggested
- Show & Share**-----Any age - only for those 4-H'ers who are **first-time participants**
- Demon/Ill. Talks**-----Individual or team of 2 - Must be enrolled in project, 2 age groups, 2 Junior, 2 Senior , Maximum time 15 minutes includes set-up & presentation
- Sr. Gavel Games** -----Teams of 4, all participants will take a written test, may not use notes, **will draw for positions.** - 10-15 minutes parliamentary presentation
- Jr. Gavel Games** -----Teams of 4, all participants will take a written test, may not use notes, will **not** draw for positions. – 10-15 minutes parliamentary presentation
- Model Meetings** -----All Club Participation, 35 minute meeting (includes roll call & recreation) Provide agenda, present secretary book notes after meeting. **Must do all 5 types of motions.**

All musical entries must bring the original sheet music for the judge and have measures numbered. Instrumental entries **will not have to be memorized. All vocal numbers must be memorized. Pre-recorded music accompaniment is allowed.
