Foods and Nutrition Project Meeting

4-Hers in the Foods and Nutrition project will have the opportunity to volunteer at Harvesters in Topeka on Saturday, April 23rd. Harvesters is a regional food bank that serves 26 counties in northwestern Missouri and northeastern Kansas. There are 10 volunteer slots available on a first come, first serve basis to Morris County 4-Hers who are enrolled in the foods and nutrition project. Please RSVP to the Extension Office (620.767.5136) by April 15th, if you are interested in volunteering. Please note that for safety purposes, 4-Hers need to be at least 8 years of age to participate. If there are still slots available after April 15th, this volunteer opportunity will be opened up to other 4-Hers who are not enrolled in the foods and nutrition project. We will plan to volunteer at Harvesters from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. 4-Hers who sign up to participate will need to meet in the Morris County Courthouse parking lot at 7:45 a.m. in order to leave for Topeka. Participants will also need to bring money with them as we plan to eat lunch together before returning home to Council Grove.

The club will earn \$10 for each event that qualifies. The Morris County 4-H Foundation will review the Morris County 4-H Club Summary Report to select winning activities. If desired, clubs may attach a note suggesting which items they feel qualify or provide further explanation to judge their promotion.

The 2016 camp dates are **June 24-27** at Rock Springs Ranch 4-H Center. Camp is open to 4-Hers who have

completed 3rd through 7th grade. Registration forms are attached to this newsletter and available on our website The Morris County 4-H flinthills.ksu.edu. Foundation will provide \$140 of support and the Flint Hills Rural Electric Cooperative will provide \$10 of support for 4-Hers to attend camp. As a result, the camp registration cost for a Morris County 4-Her is just \$35 instead of the full registration fee of \$185. Registration forms and payment are due in the Extension Office by May 16th.
