Tri-County Fair

The Tri-County Fair will be July 9th - 11th in Herington, KS. The fair will include 4-H exhibitors from Morris, Marion, and Dickinson counties. Fair papers, which include the fair guidelines and schedule, and entry cards are now available to be picked up in the Extension Office.

Morris County Fair Information

The dates of the Morris County Fair are **July 18th - July 27th**. Fair books are available from your club leaders as well as in the Extension Office. Below is a list of details to note about the 2015 fair.

***Morris County Fair Pre-Entries**

Pre-entries for **horse, open class horse, beef, sheep, swine, dairy cattle, dairy goats, meat goats, rabbits, cats, and dogs** showing at the Morris County Fair are due to the Extension Office by 5:00 p.m. on **Monday, July 6th**. **Performing Arts** entries as well as **Clothing Construction** and **Fashion Revue** forms are also due by this date.

***4-H and Open Horse Show**

The 4-H and Open Horse show will be held on **Thursday, July 23rd**, during the Morris County Fair. **Pre-entry will be required for all 4-H AND Open Class entries by July 6th.**

***Bucket Calf Show**

Bucket calf show will be at 5:30 Saturday July 25th. The Fair Board voted that there will only be one Bucket Calf Show this year. This means there will not be a separate Dairy Bucket Calf show. Both dairy breeds and beef breeds will be shown together. The Bucket Calf show is judged based on showmanship and knowledge of the project.

***4-H and Open Class Entry Check-In**

Check-in for all 4-H and Open Class non-perishable entries and livestock will be held on **Friday, July 24th** from **5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.** Check in for perishable items only (food and horticulture entries) will be held from **7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 25th.**

***Fair Supplies**

***FCS Judging Contest**

A Family and Consumer Sciences Judging Contest (FCS) will be held in conjunction with the 4-H Clothing and Fashion Revue Judging during the Morris County Fair on **Tuesday, July 21st**. This judging contest will help determine intermediate division (ages 9-13) team members for the FCS Judging Contest held at the Kansas State Fair in September. There will not be a senior division contest (ages 14-18) held at the State Fair in 2015. An event for this age division will be held in conjunction with Discovery Days in 2016.

***Talent Showcase**

4-Hers are encouraged to participate in the Talent Showcase held in conjunction with the 4-H Fashion Revue on **Tuesday, July 21st at 7:00 p.m.** in the Council Grove High School Auditorium. Examples of entries can include vocal solos, dance routines, group ensembles, readings, or dramatics. The event is open to all Morris County 4-Hers and youth do not need to be enrolled in the performing arts project to participate. Entry forms are attached to this newsletter and are due to the Extension Office by **Monday, July 6th**.

Morris County Fair Information

***Poultry Show**

Due to the fact that there will be no Poultry allowed on the fairgrounds we will have the following classes in the Poultry Project.

I15- Poultry Poster
I16- Poultry Notebook
I17- Poultry Display
I18- Other

These Classes will have a designated location inside the Community Building.

-Posters and Displays should follow the standard guidelines laid out in other areas regarding posters and display boards.

Posters= 22x28

Tri-Fold = max of 3ft x 4ft

- Please have a 4x6 picture of 4-Her and their project (chicken, duck, turkey, etc) to the Extension Office by July 20th or bring to check-in on Friday, July 24. If they are showing multiple species they can have separate pictures.

***T-Shirt & Barn Quilts**

For those who attended the T-Shirt Quilt or Barn Quilt Classes hosted by the Extension Office class number for the T-Shirt Quilt will be OM-16 for Open Class and OL-30 for Barn Quilts in Open Class.

***Photography Judging Contest**

A photography judging contest will be held **Sunday, July 26th, from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.** in the fair building. The contest will be used to determine participants for the photography judging contest held at the Kansas State Fair.

Kansas State Fair Information

The 2015 Kansas State Fair will be held **Friday, September 4th through Sunday, September 13th.**

***Pre-Entries**

In order to exhibit projects at the Kansas State Fair, 4-Hers must be 9 years old by January 1, 2015. Livestock entries must have met nomination deadlines. For other projects, 4-Hers must receive a purple ribbon at the county fair and there must be a class available at the State Fair. **Even though exhibits may be eligible for the State Fair, they must be pre-entered in the Extension Office.**

Three visual arts exhibits will be selected at the county fair to represent Morris County at the State Fair. Even though these exhibits are selected at the county level, they still must be pre-entered. Visual arts entries are for display purposes only and will be given a participation ribbon; no premium money will be awarded.

Please note the following entry deadlines:

July 15: Kansas State Fair (Grand Drive) entries for beef, sheep, swine, and meat goats are due to the Kansas State Fair Office. These entries must have a county agent's signature.

August 1: Horse entries are due to the Kansas State Fair Office. These entries must have a county agent's signature.

August 10: All other 4-H State Fair pre-entries are due to the Extension Office. Demonstration and Fashion Revue entries must also be pre-entered and are due by **August 10th.**

There will be eight contests open to youth members with cash prizes and ribbons awarded. There will be rotating tours on the K-State Ag Research Center. There is a \$5.00 per person registration cost. Pre-registration will be required by Friday, July 31st to ensure an accurate meal count and tour divisions.
