### Morris County 4-H Foundation Scholarships

Once again the Morris County 4-H Foundation is offering scholarships to present or past Morris County 4-H members. Also, please note that students can apply and receive the scholarship twice. ## Konley Harding Memorial Scholarship

### Morris County 4-H Foundation Incentive Awards

If desired, clubs may attach a note suggesting which items they feel qualify or provide further explanation to judge their promotion.

Discovery Days will be held May 31 -June 3, 2016 on the Kansas State University campus in Manhattan. This mini college experience is designed for youth who are 13-18 years of age as of January 1, 2016. The theme this year is "Get a Clue and Discover YOU." 
#### Beef Weigh-In

# K-State Animal Sciences Leadership Academy

Applications are now being accepted for the 2016 K-State Animal Sciences Leadership Academy. This intensive four-day educational experience is designed to enhance the leadership skills and animal science knowledge of students in 9th through 12th grades. The academy is being hosted by the K-State Department of Animal Sciences and Industry and sponsored by the Livestock and Meat Industry Council. There will be two sessions offered this year and are scheduled for June 8-11 and June 29-July 2 in Manhattan. Youth may apply for one or both dates as their schedule allows.
